IMPORTANT BULLETIN

Issued by Criminal Intelligence Service Nova Scotia;

A recent increase in suicides and attempted suicides in vehicles has prompted the need for emergency personnel to exercise extra safety measures when answering calls to apparent unconscious victims in parked vehicles. The suicide is referred to an "Detergent Suicide". The ingredients used produce a deadly Hydrogen Sulfide gas that once inhaled acts as an asphyxiate. The scene safety practices are all documented on the Bulletin release. It is posted on the bulletin board at the fire hall.
